### **Summary of Interagency Cooperation**

April - June 2020

The period April to June 2020 saw the Turks and Caicos Islands continuing to operate under a full "shelter in place" order which commenced on 27<sup>th</sup> March 2020. This order was partially lifted on 3<sup>rd</sup> May 2020 with resumption of office hours for the Commission on a limited basis from 10<sup>th</sup> May to 22<sup>nd</sup> June 2020. Although the Commission continued 'working from home' during the 'shelter in place' order, there was a significant reduction of requests during the period presumably because of the Covid-19 crisis. It is, however, anticipated that with the slow return to normal working conditions globally, that Interagency Cooperation numbers will increase.


