Summary of Enforcement Actions

April - June 2020

The period April to June 2020 saw the Turks and Caicos Islands continuing to operate under a full "shelter in place" order which commenced on 27th March 2020. This order was partially lifted on 3rd May 2020 with resumption of limited office hours from 10th May to 22nd June 2020. Although the Commission continued 'working from home' during the 'shelter in place' order, there was a significant reduction in enforcement during the period because of the Covid-19 crisis. It is, however, anticipated that with the slow return to normal working conditions globally, that enforcement action numbers will increase.
