ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida

- 1. The International Division of the Attorney General's Chambers advises that four (4) entries have been corrected and 28 entries have been amended in the ISIL (Da'esh) and Al-Qaida regime¹. They are still subject to an asset freeze.
- 2. This follows an update to the UK Sanctions List. The consolidated list of asset freeze targets has been updated to reflect these changes.
