Counter-Terrorism (International)

- The International Division of the Attorney General's Chambers advises that seven (7) entries have been added to the <u>Counter-Terrorism (International) regime¹</u> and are now subject to an asset freeze.
- 2. This follows an update to the UK Sanctions List. The consolidated list of asset freeze targets has been updated to reflect these changes.
