FINANCIAL SANCTIONS NOTICE FSN-119-23

Iran

- The International Division of the Attorney General's Chambers advises that one hundred and seventy-three (173) entries have been amended to transfer them from the Iran (Human Rights) regime to the <u>Iran regime</u>¹ and are still subject to an asset freeze.
- 2. Eight (8) entries have been added to the Iran regime and are now subject to an asset freeze.
- 3. This follows an update to the UK Sanctions List. The Consolidated List of asset freeze targets has been updated to reflect these changes.
