## Cyber

- The International Division of the Attorney General's Chambers advises that sixteen (16) entries have been added to the <u>Cyber Financial Sanctions Regime</u><sup>1</sup> and are now subject to an asset freeze.
- 2. This follows an update to the UK Sanctions List. The consolidated list of asset freeze targets has been updated to reflect these changes.
