## **Belarus**

- 1. The International Division of the Attorney General's Chambers advises that six (6) entries have been added to the <u>Belarus regime</u><sup>1</sup> and are now subject to an asset freeze.
- 2. This follows an update to the UK Sanctions List. The consolidated list of asset freeze targets has been updated to reflect this change.
