Russia

- The International Division of the Attorney General's Chambers advises that three (3) entries have been corrected in the <u>Russia regime</u>¹ and are still subject to an asset freeze and trust services sanctions.
- 2. Further, the following entry has been amended under the Russia regime and remains subject to an asset freeze and trust services sanctions
 - Mikhail Maratovic FRIDMAN (Group ID: 14615
- 3. This follows an update to the UK Sanctions List. The consolidated list of asset freeze targets has been updated to reflect thess changes.
